- Pencil
- 1 piece corrugated cardboard
- Glue
- Utility knife*
- Tape
- · Decorative stick or wand

Instructions

- 1. Download and print the mask on white paper.
- 2. Color in the mask.
- 3. Cut out the mask shape with scissors, including eye holes.
- 4. Trace the shape of the mask onto cardboard with a pencil.
- 5. Glue the mask to cardboard.
- 6. Use a utility knife* to cut out the mask shape, including eye holes.
- 7. Tape the mask to a stick or wand.
